Thursday 15th March 2018 at 2pm Polo Grounds RING 2

Class 451. Side Saddle Concours d'Elegance EF: \$ 20 PM: \$ 50, 40, 30, 15. Ribbons to 6th place.

(Open to juniors and seniors)

Class 452. Junior Side Saddle Combination EF: \$ 20 PM: \$ 50, 40, 30, 15. Ribbons to 6th place.

Age – under 17 years on 31st March 2017

Class 453. Title Class- HOY Side Saddle Unity of the Year

EF: \$55: \$150, 100, 50, 25. Ribbons to 6th place.

(Open to juniors and seniors)

This is a 3 phase Unity judged per NZSSA Unity Scoresheet & Rules comprising:

Class 453 Phase A - Best Side Saddle Turnout: 1st to 6th ribbons only & the winner will receive the Best Presented Sash.

Class 453 Phase B - Best Rider Side Saddle: 1st to 6th ribbons only

Class 453 Phase C - Best Side Saddle Mount: 1st to 6th ribbons only

Points / placings awarded for each of the 3 phases will be combined to determine the overall Title Class Awards. A Rider must present in all 3 phases to be eligible for a Title Class Award.

Phases may not be entered individually. Each rider may compete on one mount only in this section. Class 453 Phase A - Best Side Saddle Turnout will be judged in a line-up and may

also be judged on the circle. Workout(s) will be advised to those entered. One or more workout(s) will form part of the judging for Class 453 – Phases B & C.

Conditions for Side Saddle Riders:

- A completed Certificate of Capability must be received by the HOY Side Saddle Convenor before your entry will be accepted
- An approved hard hat must be worn at all times whilst mounted.
