1. Entries close and must be received no later than **1<sup>st</sup> February 2018**
2. All entries must be submitted online via [www.equestrianentries.co.nz](http://www.equestrianentries.co.nz)
3. No entries will be accepted until payment IN FULL is received
4. Entry Fees are \$30 per class - all other fees as per HOY schedule
5. Prior Qualification requirements - Article 137 / 4.1 Qualifications for National Pinnacle Events

### Conditions of Entry:

1. This event is run under ESNZ Para-Equestrian Rules, ESNZ Generals Rules and Regulations and ESNZ Dressage Rules where applicable
2. The official start time for Para Equestrian is Wed 13<sup>th</sup> March 2018
3. All riders and horses must be current, full members of ESNZ
4. **All Three Tests** count toward the title for each grade – Freestyle is weighted 1.5
5. All Para-Equestrian riders must have a current FEI Classification, and / or an ESNZ Para-Equestrian National Classification.

6. Riders are to wear two (one each side) orange disks on their saddle blankets at all times whilst riding at any time for ease of identification by stewards
7. The Para-Equestrian Dressage draw will be available at [www.equestrianentries.co.nz](http://www.equestrianentries.co.nz), and [www.hoy.co.nz](http://www.hoy.co.nz)
8. SCRATCHINGS as per HOY General Conditions.
9. Arena Familiarization times and Riders Briefing times will be advised no later than one week prior to the start of the competition.
10. **CAMPING & STABLING** – Please **STATE CLEARLY** on your forms in the **YARDING** requirements box that you are competing in Para classes including if you are also competing in other disciplines
