# Thursday 15th March 2018 Start 9am – Polo Grounds, Hawkes Bay Show Grounds

Please read these conditions carefully. You must read all the HOY Regulations & Conditions of entry and abide by them. It is the responsibility of the Rider/Handler/Person Responsible to know the rules of the class in which they are competing

#### **Conditions**

- 1. Only Standardbreds with an official harness racing freeze brands are eligible to enter
- Owner must be a current financial member of the NISA, NZSRA or NZSBA at close of entries
- 3. Breastplate number holders or armbands are **compulsory** and the competitor is responsible for making the number. Only large black numbers on a white background are acceptable. No other colour combinations or formats are acceptable
- 4. Height Certificates Are not required for this section
- 5. **Qualification** All horses (excluding foals) MUST have won a Champion Standardbred or two Reserve Champion Standardbred or two wins in a qualifying class **between 1<sup>st</sup> March 2017 & 4<sup>th</sup> March 2018** in the Standardbred ring at a qualifying show.

You must have won One Champion Inhand or Two Reserve Champions Inhand or two wins in an Inhand qualifying class at a qualifying show to enter the Inhand section. Qualifying classes for Inhand include Youngstock, Mare/Filly or Gelding/Stallion classes (ie conformation classes)

You must have won One OPEN Champion Ridden or Two OPEN Reserve Champions Ridden or two OPEN wins in a ridden qualifying class at a qualifying show to enter the ridden section. Qualifying classes for ridden include Open or Lady's Standardbred (Novice wins or Novice Champions do not count for qualification).

- 6. **Attendance** All horses (excluding foals) MUST have competed at a minimum of three (3) RAS qualifying shows (excluding HOY 2017) in a Standardbred section between **between 1**<sup>st</sup> **March 2017 & 4**<sup>th</sup> **March 2018**
- 7. Qualifying & Attendance Shows are ALL RAS affiliated shows, Canterbury Horse & Pony Breeders Show, North Island Standardbred Association's North Island Championship & Pleasure Horse Show (only Inhand & Ridden Championship ring to qualify), NZSRA Championship show (only Open rings to qualify) or South Island Premier Championship Show

8. Novice – Is a horse that has **not** won 6 or more 1st in a Standardbred Ridden conformation class at a Qualifying show (Novice, Open, Lady's) by 4<sup>th</sup> March 2018. Novice horses are eligible to enter if they have qualified
