Riders may only start one horse in Class 240 but may start two in Class 242 if there are less than 15 horses qualified.

CDIY must gain 60% in Class 237 to qualify for Class 241. Riders may only start 1 horse in Class 241 .  
Prize money may be adjusted within FEI & ESNZ rules

### **Conditions for Young Dressage Horse**

1. The age of horses is taken from the 1st August. Imported horses from Northern Hemisphere the age is taken as at 1 January.
2. All horses competing at HOY in ESNZ dressage classes must be registered with ESNZ and have an annual dressage start.
3. Proof of age of horses must be supplied with entry. ESNZ ID Books will be accepted but must be signed by a veterinarian. Entries will not be accepted without proof of age
4. All tests to be ridden in sitting trot.
5. Tests will be ridden one horse at a time in the arena.
6. The flying change requirement in the 6yr old test is optional.
7. Tests may be called.
8. Whips are permitted to be carried.
9. 4, 5 and 6 yr olds to be ridden in a snaffle as defined by DNZ rules and regs.
10. The age group Champion will be the combination that gains the highest cumulative total marks from Rounds 1 and 2.
11. If there is an equal placing for Champion, the winner will be the combination that has the highest combined total score for 'Overall Perspective'.
12. In the first round for the 4, 5 and 6 yr old classes, the judges will sit together at E; in the second round the Judges will sit together at C.
13. In both rounds for the 7 year old classes, the technical judge will sit at C, and the judges assessing the quality will sit together at E or B.
