Conditions of Entry

- All Exhibits Must be Fully Registered in the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of New Zealand Purebred Stud Book or the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of New Zealand Part Bred Register. Copy of Registration to be sent to - Jo Linton RD3 Omarunui Rd Hastings carried and sighted on the day.
- All Stallions must be Stallion Registered. All entries regardless of age must have a, S, stallion badge fixed to the bridle both sides, to be shown in a bit & to be handled by a person over 14 yrs. Handlers to wear S stallion Bibs when outside the ring.
- No Height limit in the Part Bred Classes
- All entries are to be via the Equestrian Entries website. If not current members of ESNZ, Community Membership is required and can be done easily by going to www.nzequestrian.org.nz
- The General conditions of Entries as per Land Rover Horse of the Year must be abided by.
- Open Ridden classes, the rider can be any age. (Stallions can be ridden by rider 14 years and over) Refer to RAS rule re ridden stallions
- Ridden Exhibits can compete in Open Welsh / Welsh Lead Rein / Welsh First Ridden Classes as long as they have different riders and are eligible to compete.
- LEAD REIN Riders 4 to 7 years inclusive
- Lead Rein Rider can compete in this section with no penalty. They can also compete in the showing section lead rein Pony of the Year/ Lead Rein Rider of the Year if they have met all qualifying conditions as in the Rules and Conditions of entry in the Showing section. LEAD REIN RIDERS CANNOT COMPETE IN ANY OTHER SECTION AT LAND ROVER HORSE OF THE YEAR OTHER THAN LEAD REIN SECTION IN THE SHOWING.
- All Lead Rein Ponies to be 128cm & under and to be led by a leader 14 yrs older with Leading rein attached to noseband of snaffle bridle.
- No Spurs to be worn in Lead Rein or First Ridden.



WELSH SECTION SCHEDULE 2019

- Whips with a flapper 4cm long and 2cm wide with total length 68cm long or small cane may be carried.
- First Ridden Riders 9 Years and under.
- First Ridden Rider can compete in this section with no penalty. They can also compete in the showing section First Ridden Pony of the Year/ First Ridden Rider of the Year if they have met all qualifying condition as in the Rules and Conditions of entry in the Showing section.
FIRST RIDDEN RIDERS CANNOT COMPETE IN ANY OTHER SECTION AT LAND ROVER HORSE OF THE YEAR OTHER THAN FIRST RIDDEN SECTION IN THE SHOWING.
- All First Ridden Exhibits to be 138cm & under snaffles bits only.
- Pure bred are not to be plaited and will not be penalized if manes are pulled.
- Number Holders are compulsory.
- The Judge's Decision is Final.
